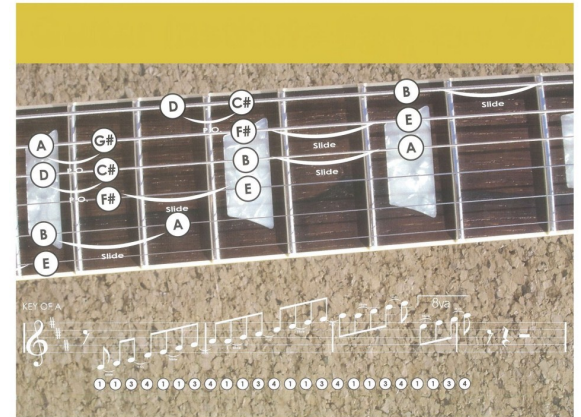

He continues his education today with Dale Brunning. Paul has free-lanced as a guitar player and post-production audio engineer. He writes and performs music for radio, television, theatre and film. Paul teaches private guitar and bass lessons to students of all ages from around the Denver-metro area.

Paul's current and past students perform in various venues around the country and have gone onto professional and semi-professional music careers.
